



CEO New York - Voter Registration Guide



In New York, You're Eligible to Vote if:

- You are *not* in state prison or federal prison for a felony conviction.
- You *can* vote if you are still on probation or parole.
- You're a United States citizen and a resident of New York and the county, city, or village for at least 30 days before Election Day
- You're at least 18 years old on Election Day
- You are not found mentally incompetent to vote by a court
- Due to voter rolls being purged, sometimes individuals who are eligible and registered to vote are removed. You can check whether you're still registered to vote <https://www.vote.org/am-i-registered-to-vote/>

Where and How to Register to Vote

To register online:

You can register to vote online at <https://register.vote.org/?partner=781667>

- To register online you will need your New York State driver's license or New York identification card number, the last four digits of your social security number, and your date of birth.
- You must register by October 14, 2022
- If you will need your ballot mailed to you, fill out [this form](#) by October 24

Where and When to Vote

- The 2022 Midterm election will take place on **Tuesday, November 8th**.
- You can vote in person or by mail before Election Day. You can find the nearest place to vote at <https://www.vote.org/polling-place-locator/>
- Your ballot must be returned in person or postmarked by November 8



Additional Information

- If you have already registered to vote but have since moved, be sure to update your registration with your new address.
- Under New York State law, you are eligible for up to two hours of paid time off to vote, unless you have four consecutive hours to vote either from the opening of the polls to the closing of the polls. Alternatively, you can vote by mail.
- Registered voters do not need to show ID to vote, unless they did not provide identification with their registration.
