

CEO North Carolina - Voter Registration Guide



In North Carolina, You're Eligible to Vote if:

- You are *not* in jail or prison
- You *can* vote if you are still on probation or parole.
- You're a United States citizen and a resident of the county in which you are registering for at least 30 days before Election Day
- You're at least 18 years old on Election Day (16- and 17-year-olds may preregister)
- Due to voter rolls being purged, sometimes individuals who are eligible and registered to vote are removed. You can check whether you're still registered to vote <https://www.vote.org/am-i-registered-to-vote/>

Where and How to Register to Vote

To register online:

You can register to vote online at <https://register.vote.org/?partner=781667>

- You must provide ID information (North Carolina Driver's License number or North Carolina State ID number) in order to apply to vote by mail.
- The voter registration deadline is October 14, 2022. (After October 14, 2022, only same-day registration during one-stop early voting is available.)
- If you will need your ballot mailed to you, fill out [this form](#) by Nov 1

Where and When to Vote

- The 2022 midterm election will take place on **Tuesday, November 8th**.
- You can vote in person or by mail before Election Day. You can find the nearest place to vote at <https://www.vote.org/polling-place-locator/>
- Your ballot must be returned in person or postmarked by November 8
- One notary public or two witnesses must be in your presence when you mark your absentee ballot. They should only observe you marking your ballot, not how you vote.
